

# JUICING

Code Section(s): 3-404.11, 3-801.11

## Definition of Juice

- **Juice** is one or more fruits or vegetables that has been liquified or pureed and meant to be served as a beverage.

## Products and equipment

- Produce must be washed with all stickers removed before processing the products.
- Equipment, Utensils, and Machines must be properly washed and sanitized on a routine basis

## Packaging

If juice will be pre-packaged on of the following must occur:

### Treated:

Must provide HACCP Plans

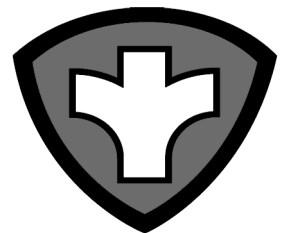
Pasteurized to meet a 5-log reduction in bacterial growth of microorganisms that pose a significant public health risk.

### Untreated:

May not be served to highly susceptible populations including children under 9 at schools, daycares, or similar establishments.

Must be properly labeled along with the following warning statement:

*“WARNING: This product has not been pasteurized and, therefore, may contain harmful bacteria that can cause serious illness in children, the elderly, and persons with weakened immune systems.”*
